










**Bluff.** A topographic feature such as a hill, cliff or embankment having the following characteristics (an area with an average slope of less than 18% over a distance for 50 feet or more shall not be considered part of the bluff):

- a. Part or all of the feature is located in a shoreland area;
- b. The slope rises at least 25 feet above the ordinary high water level of the waterbody;
- c. The grade of the slope from the toe of the bluff to a point 25 feet or more above the ordinary high water level averages 30% or greater; and
- d. The slope must drain toward the waterbody.

**Bluff Impact Zone.** A bluff and land located within 20 feet from the top of a bluff.

**Shorewood Code 1201.26, Subd. 5, d: Bluff Impact zones.** Structures and accessory facilities, except stairways, lifts and landings, must not be placed within bluff impact zones

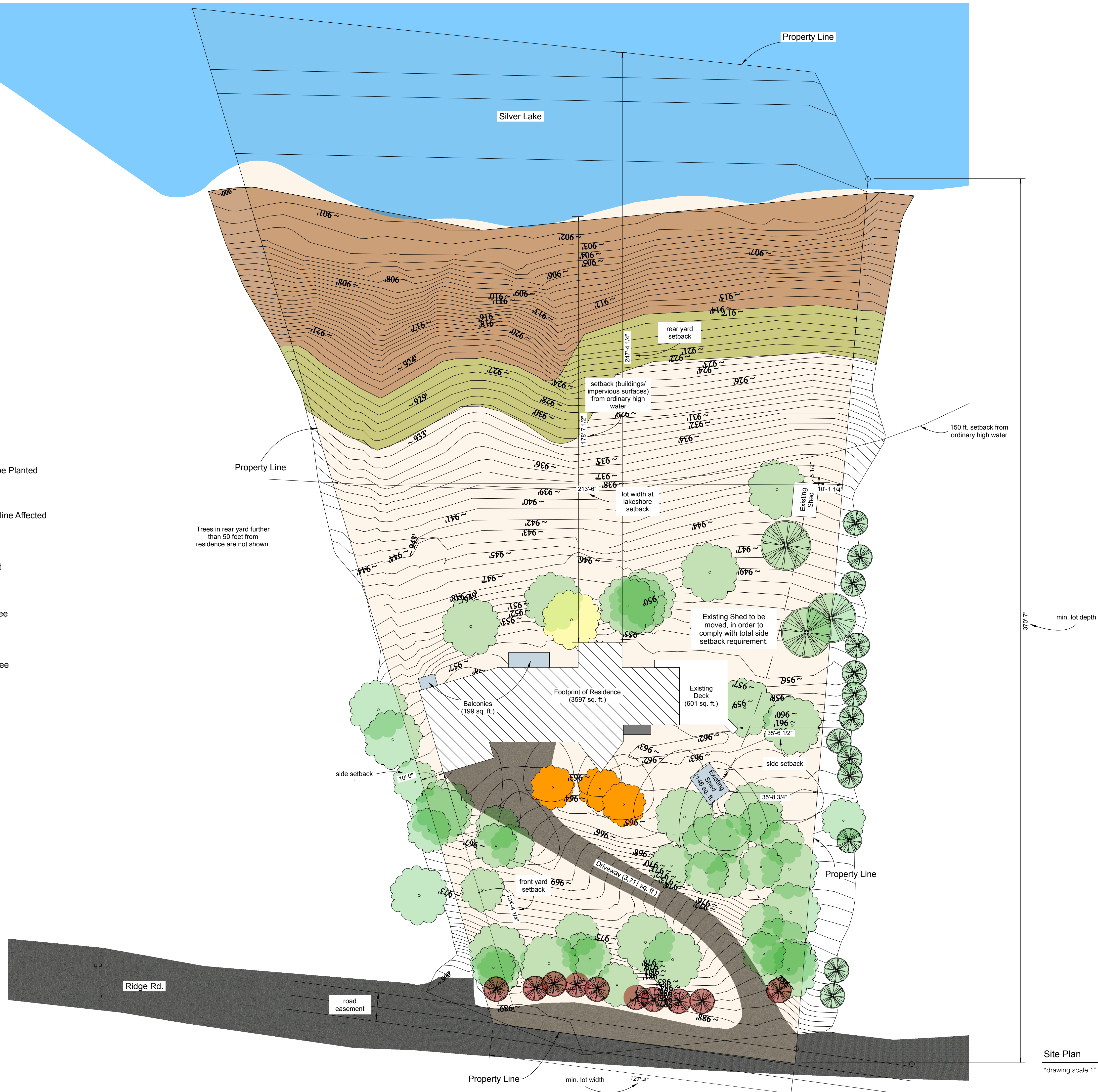

**Shorewood Tree Preservation and Replacement Policy**

**Significant Trees:** Any healthy long-lived hardwood deciduous tree measuring eight inches (8") DBH or greater; any healthy softwood deciduous tree measuring twelve inches (12") DBH or greater; or any healthy coniferous tree measuring eight feet (8') or more in height. Box-elder, cottonwood, and willow trees shall not be considered to be significant trees.

Except as provided in IV.13. of this Policy, all significant trees removed or damaged during the process of land development or construction activities shall be replaced on site.

**Tree Replacement Ratio:**  
 - Significant deciduous trees eight inches (8") DBH or greater shall be replaced by two (2), three (3) inch caliper or greater deciduous trees or two, six-foot (6') high coniferous trees.  
 - Significant deciduous trees twelve inches (12") DBH or greater shall be replaced by three (3), three (3) inch caliper or greater deciduous trees or three (3), six-foot (6') high coniferous trees.
